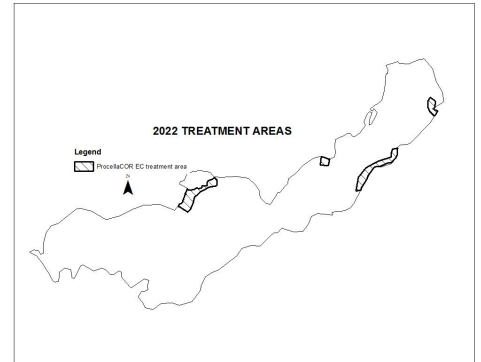


WARNING

AQUATIC PESTICIDE IN USE

Due to aquatic herbicide use in Lake Fairlee with SePRO ProcellaCOR EC (active ingredient florpyrauxifen-benzyl), authorized under Aquatic Nuisance Control Permit #3382-ANC-C, the following advisory water use restrictions are in effect for the entire lake and outlet stream.



LAKE WATER ADVISORY USE RESTRICTIONS

- NO USE of Lake Fairlee waters and water from the outlet stream FOR ANY PURPOSE including boating, fishing, swimming, domestic (household) use or irrigation, the day of treatment on:

Monday, June 20, 2022, beginning at 9 am

- Swimming/wading, boating and fishing may resume on:

Tuesday, June 21, 2022, beginning at 9 am

- WATER USE from Lake Fairlee and from the outlet stream FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES may resume on:

Date to Be Filled In Later Per Treatment Follow Up Testing Results

- USE of water from Lake Fairlee FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES including for watering lawns, trees, or other plants may resume on:

Date to Be Filled In Later Per Treatment Follow Up Testing Results

Bottled water is available upon request by the Lake Fairlee Association (contact information below) to any person restricted from using its domestic water supply for drinking or food or drink preparation.
